**CALL TO ORDER – Councilmember Reed (Acting Mayor)**

- Council member Reed, Acting Mayor called the Public Hearing to order at 6:45 p.m.

Pat Finney, Council member and member of the Cemetery Board, stated that they used the City of New Ulm’s cemetery rules and regulations as a guideline and that Stephen Michel, City Administrator, had called monument companies for their input.

John Valen, City Attorney, noted the changes as follows: Spelling error on page 2, line 1. On Page 5, under Ownership, Leave #1 as is, add #2. If there is no surviving spouse, then to the decedent’s eldest surviving child; and #3. If there is no surviving child, then to the decedent’s youngest surviving sibling; and change #2 to #4.

Council member Finney also noted that there would be a sign erected at the cemetery with some of the rules and the last line will read, “Pick up rules and regulations at City Hall”. Also the rules and regulations will be sent to funeral homes, monument companies, etc.

Council member Reed, Acting Mayor asked for comments or concerns from the audience. No comments or concerns were expressed.
