Mayor Walhof opened the Public Hearing and acknowledged a letter of objection from WHA School Districts Attorney. He then turned the Public Hearing over to Will Hoyt, and Tyler Koos from Landecker and Associates. Mr. Hoyt presented the projected costs of this project to the audience, and what it would involve.

Kelly Nelson spoke to Council on how he felt about the assessments, and how he felt it wouldn't increase his property value, but would decrease it due too increased traffic in the area.

Will Hoyt also explained that Sewer could possibly be ran to the McMurrin property at an estimated cost of \$36,000.00, or a lift station could be installed for somewhere between \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00 dollars.
