January 2006 – Advertise for bids and arrange for bonding or other financing.

February 2006 – Open bids and award construction contracts.

April 2006 – Begin Construction

August 2006 – End Construction and prepare the final assessment roll.

September 2006 – Hold final assessment hearing.

Lee Westfield, Walker Area Community Center spoke to the Council and Audience on the importance of these improvements to the Community Center, and how they perceived the assessment roll.
